## Event Staff Payment Policy

Working at any event on behalf of Bread & Flowers will be on a Self-Employed basis. This means it will be your responsibility to declare any income to HMRC. All payments made by Bread & Flowers will be made to you gross with no tax or NI deducted.

### Payment Procedure

- You will be required to sign in using the Staff Sign in Sheet which will detail your start and finish times.
- The FOH Manager will sign off the times as correct and confirm timings on the timesheet in the job file, which will be completed by Monday lunchtime.
- Mandy will calculate your payments for hours worked and any travel or mileage due.
- Payments will be made by BACS into your bank account.
- Payments will normally be processed on a Monday afternoon but in event of any delays they will be in your account on the Tuesday.
- Mandy will email you a statement of what has been paid into your account and how this has been calculated.

### Pay rates

#### Under 18

£6.50 per hour for the first 2 jobs you work

£7.00 per hour for the next 4 jobs

£8.00 per hour going forwards

(Living wage for under 18 = £6.40)

#### 18 - 20

£9.00 per hour for the first 6 jobs you work.

£10.00 per hour going forwards.

(Living wage for 18 – 20 = £8.60)

#### 21+

£11.50 - £12 per hour depending on experience
